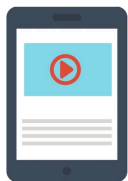


EPSB Together Literacy & Numeracy App

These videos focus on concepts that are key to success in junior high, although the material may also help students from Grades 4–12.



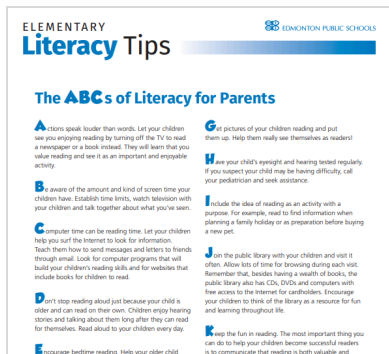

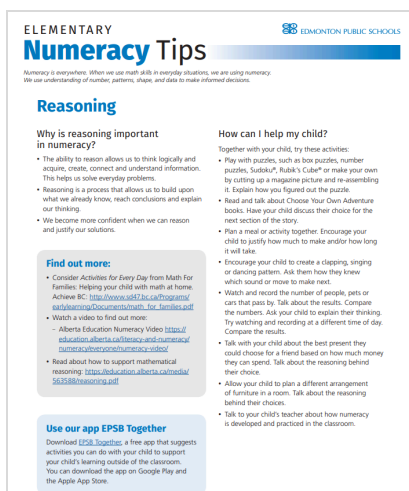
